DY8 Resources for Chart Based/EHR Measures

Databook 6.0 will be posted on the New Jersey DSRIP website on Wednesday, January 15, 2020. A clean version and a redlined version will be posted so that changes can be easily found. This update contains small revisions to three Chart Based/EHR Measures which are identified in the revision log. Databook 6.0 should be used for calculating DY8 Chart Based/EHR Measures.

Coming soon:

Standard Reporting Workbooks (SRWs) and Measure Validation Templates (MVTs) for DY8 will be posted on the SFTP by Wednesday, January 15, 2020. Please use these latest versions of the documents for submitting DY8 data. Completed SRW and MVT are to be uploaded to the [SFTP](#) by **March 31, 2020**.

Based on hospital feedback received in DY7, the format of the MVT has been updated for the following measures:

- DSRIP #21 Central Line-Associated Bloodstream Infection (CLABSI) Event
- DSRIP #61 Medication Reconciliation
- DSRIP #63 Pediatric Central-Line Associated Bloodstream Infections (CLABSI) – Neonatal Intensive Care Unit and Pediatric Intensive Care Unit,
- DSRIP #110 Screenings and Appropriate Follow-Up for Potential Substance Use Disorder and Depression by Primary Care and Behavioral Health Providers.

DY8 attribution rosters will be posted on the SFTP later in January. Hospitals will be sent a notification when they are available.

Be Prepared for NJ DSRIP Reporting: Test Your SFTP Access Today!

If you are one of your DSRIP team's Secure File Transfer Portal (SFTP) Users, please take a few moments to ensure that you are able to log into your NJ DSRIP [SFTP](#) account.

As the release of SRWs, MVTs, and DY8 attribution rosters approaches, we want to ensure that hospitals can access these materials in a timely fashion. DSRIP hospital team members can help us achieve this goal by testing their access to their SFTP accounts before these reporting materials are released.

Please email the NJ DSRIP team, njdsrip@pcgus.com, if you need help accessing your SFTP account or are encountering any other technical difficulties related to the SFTP. The process to reset credentials on an SFTP account can take up to five business days, so please bring any SFTP access issues to our attention as soon as possible.
