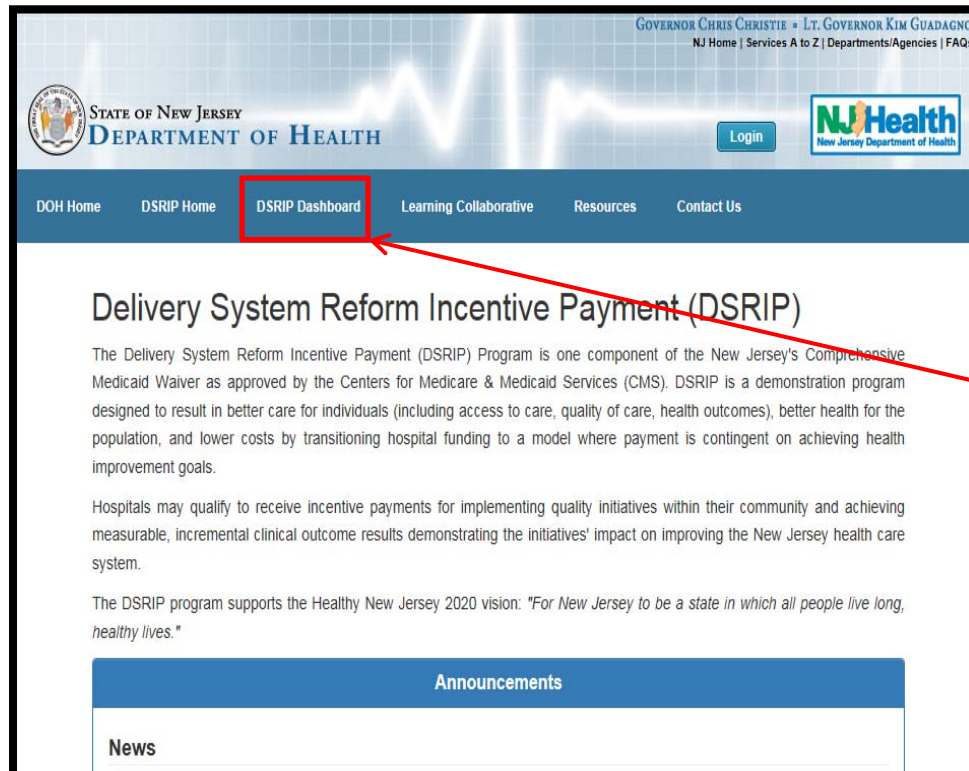
## DY4 Q2 Progress Reports – Overview

- All of the progress reports have been submitted to CMS for review
- **State findings:**
  - Missing minimum submission documentation is a continued issue.
  - 67% of hospitals received a write-back in DY4 Q2.
  - Number of write-backs increased from DY4 Q1 to DY4 Q2.
- **Next Steps:**
  - State will be hosting a webinar on Thursday January 14, 2016 on Progress Report completion which will **replace January's Learning Collaborative**; a Question and Answer time will be available after the presentation.

## DY4 Q2 Progress Reports – Overview *Continued*

- NEW Attachment Document Naming Limitations
  - Document names are now limited to 70 characters.
  - Document names cannot include the following special characters: Tilde (~), Number sign (#), Percent (%), Ampersand (&), Asterisk (\*), Braces { }, Backslash (\), Colon (:), Angle brackets (< >), Question mark (?), Slash (/), Plus sign (+), Pipe (|), Quotation mark (").
  - Document names cannot contain multiple periods (...).
  - Document names can use underscore (\_), dash (-), and period (.).
  
- Document naming recommendation
  - Abbreviated Hospital Name\_Activity\_Activity13.Document Number
  - Example: RBH\_Activity\_13.1
  - Example: RBH\_Activity\_13.2
  - Naming convention when all activities are in one attached document
    - Example: RBH\_Activities\_All

## Delivery System Reform Incentive Payment (DSRIP)

The Delivery System Reform Incentive Payment (DSRIP) Program is one component of the New Jersey's Comprehensive Medicaid Waiver as approved by the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS). DSRIP is a demonstration program designed to result in better care for individuals (including access to care, quality of care, health outcomes), better health for the population, and lower costs by transitioning hospital funding to a model where payment is contingent on achieving health improvement goals.

Hospitals may qualify to receive incentive payments for implementing quality initiatives within their community and achieving measurable, incremental clinical outcome results demonstrating the initiatives' impact on improving the New Jersey health care system.

The DSRIP program supports the Healthy New Jersey 2020 vision: "For New Jersey to be a state in which all people live long, healthy lives."

# NJ DSRIP Partnerships- A Formula for Success

## *Why do I need partners?*

The DSRIP program provides an opportunity to improve patient care for New Jersey's low income population by incentivizing delivery system reforms that improve access, enhance quality of care, and promote the health of patients and the families you serve.

A critical part of the DSRIP program reform design is the **requirement** for hospitals to reach "outside their walls" to partner with others to achieve the core achievement themes as listed in the Funding and Mechanics Protocol:

Improved Care/Case Management	Improved Access to Care
Improved Discharge Planning	Improved Patient Education
Expansion of Primary Care	Improved Delivery of Care
Improved Quality of Care	Improved Training and Efficiency





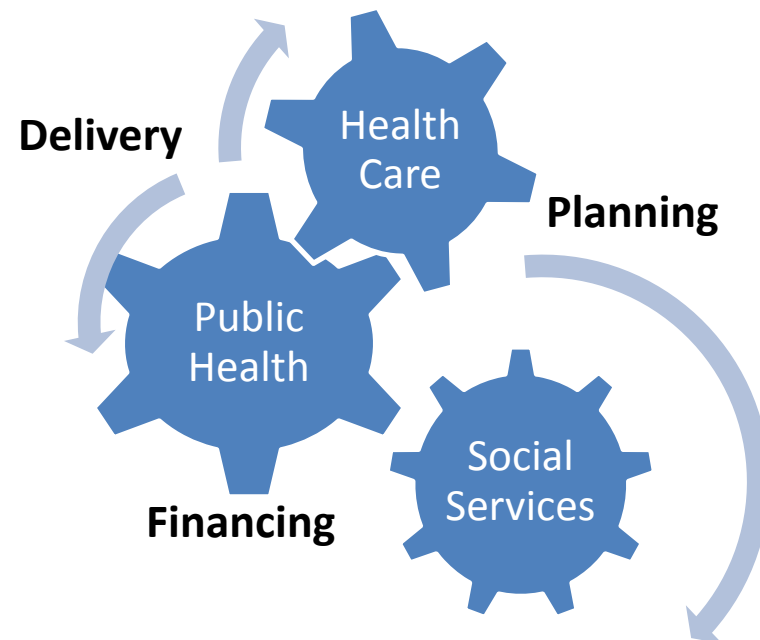
# NJ DSRIP Partnerships- A Formula for Success

# Definitions and Roles of Project Partners

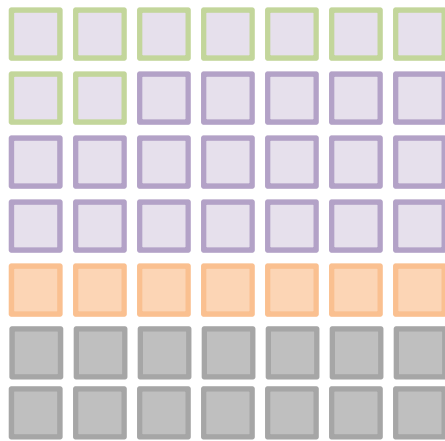


- Supports reporting requirements to receive full Stage 3 and Stage 4 incentive awards, including pay for performance achievement.
- Fulfills all performance measure obligations per the databook.
- Downloads patient roster from secure site and matches to internal systems.
- Abstracts, computes and submits outpatient measure data to hospital, or allows hospital, or third-party staff to fulfill these requirements.

## Definitions and Roles of Project Partners

■ **35** of **49** DSRIP Hospitals Have a reporting partner.

■ **9** hospitals have enhanced reporting partners.



■ **28** hospitals qualify for the Gap Reduction incentive (8%).

# How can I see my reporting partners' performance?

Chart/EHR measures that include contributions from reporting partners are accessible in the measures results section of the web portal.

Numerator, denominator, and initial patient totals are reported at the reporting-partner level of detail.

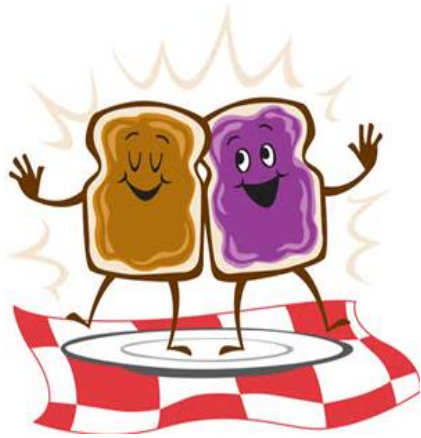

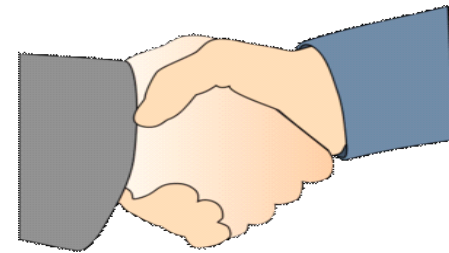
