Subject: Website Hosting Transition and Potential Downtime

August 15th, 2018

After September 15, 2018, Public Consulting Group (PCG) will be the primary NJ DSRIP consultant for New Jersey. In preparation for this transition, PCG will begin hosting the NJ DSRIP website during the week of August 27th. The website may experience a brief period of downtime during this transition. Should you have difficulty accessing the NJ DSRIP website during the week of August 27th, please contact PCG at NJDSRIP@pcgus.com.

Features remaining consistent:

- The NJ DSRIP website URL, <https://dsrip.nj.gov/>, will remain the same throughout this transition.
- The layout and content of the pages that do not require a log-in to view will remain unchanged.

Features that will change:

After the transition takes place, user access to the following items will be modified as described below:

- The portal

The portal on the website is currently used to submit materials like progress reports, access SRW templates and perform the payment packet measure acknowledgments, among other things. PCG is developing new systems to replace these functions of the website. Please note that the content and expectations of program milestones will not change, only the method to submit them. PCG will issue detailed instructions to hospitals on how to submit DY6 measure acknowledgments, DY6 appeals, and DY7 progress reports with advanced notice.

- The performance dashboard

When PCG begins hosting the website, the performance dashboards will be temporarily unavailable. PCG plans to launch a new version of the performance dashboards when the DY6 performance data is adjudicated and final, which is estimated to take place in January 2019.

The current performance dashboards were last updated with the final adjudicated data from DY5 in January 2018. The dashboards currently display hospitals' past performance and how their performance compares with the larger cohort of participating hospitals through the end of DY5.

Each hospital has the ability to download reports from these performance dashboard visualizations and is encouraged to do so before August 27th. After the transition, hospitals can continue to view their past performance data by reviewing their previously issued payment packets from DY4 and DY5. If a hospital has lost or cannot locate their DY4 and DY5 payment packets, they can email NJDSRIP@pcgus.com to request a copy at any time.
